Notes on Gift Aid Declaration:

1. If your declaration covers donations you may make in the future:
 - Please notify the Society if you change your name or address while the declaration is still in force
 - You can cancel the declaration at any time by notifying the Society – it will then not apply to donations you make on or after the date of cancellation or such later date as you specify
2. You must pay an amount of income tax and/or capital gains tax at least equal to the tax that the Society reclaims on your donations in the tax year (currently 28p for each £1 you give).
3. If in the future your circumstances change and you no longer pay tax on your income and capital gains equal to the tax that the Society reclaims, you can cancel your declaration (see note 1).
4. If you pay tax at the higher rate you can claim further tax relief in you Self Assessment tax return.
5. If you are unsure whether your donations qualify for Gift Aid tax relief, ask the Society. Or you can ask your local tax office for leaflet IR113 *Gift Aid*.

Privileges of Membership:

The primary purpose of membership is to support the Objects of the Society. Additionally, specific privileges are offered to the member as follows:

1. Free admission to all the Museum exhibits for the member and one guest.
2. A Year Book with articles of relevant interest, and occasional Bulletins concerning the activities of the Society.
3. A reception and buffet (at cost to those attending) following the Annual General Meeting.
4. Admission to special lectures and other social events organised or sponsored by the Friends.
5. Access to the Museum's library and archives by special request.
6. Special tours to places of maritime interest, in conjunction with the Friends of the RN and RM Museums.
7. Reciprocal arrangements with other museums, eg RN Museum, RM Museum, SS Great Britain and the Cutty Sark at Greenwich.
